

- 1. Peter will be available at the careers event to provide students with advice and information about Engineering and running your own business.
- 14. The University of Derby's College of Engineering and Technology- Roy Parker represents the two departments that belong to the University of Derby's college of Engineering and Technology including: The Department of Engineering and The Department of Computing and Maths.
