If you wish to discuss your child with a member of staff, in the first instance we ask that you contact their Form Tutor or the relevant member of the pastoral team listed above.


It is a privilege to work with the young people who attend the Academy. All members of the pastoral team work extremely hard and are totally committed to ensuring that every student achieves their full potential.
