This academic year, we are offering our current Year 10 cohort the chance to see ‘Macbeth’, one of their key GCSE texts, live on stage on Tuesday 15th May 2018. We have decided to offer this invaluable opportunity to enable students to gain a wider understanding of the play and the techniques it uses for their upcoming GCSE exams.

We will be leaving school at **4.00pm**, in order to arrive at the venue in time for our 6.30pm performance, and we expect to be back at school at approximately **11.30pm**. Students are to wear uniform to school and can bring a change of clothes to get changed into at the end of the day.
