Edexcel A-level Geography Student Revision Webinar: Exam skills

I am delighted to inform you that we have been able to get access to an exam skills session delivered by the Chief examiners. The purpose of the session is to thoroughly prepare your son/daughter for this summer's exams and focus on the exam skills they need to turn content knowledge into good answers by:

- Looking at how to interpret questions, key words and command words
- Discussing the demands of different exam questions from short-answer questions to full, evaluative essays
- Finding out more about the synoptic skills that are assessed in Paper 3 and how to 'think like a geographer'

Students attending will need to bring their A level folders and a pen to make notes. The feedback session will take place in the main hall and will start promptly at 3.25pm and finish at 5.15pm.

The **cost of this revision will be £2.00 per student**. The law does not allow us to make a charge for this type of activity, though we may ask for voluntary contributions.
