My Life My View Survey

Derbyshire County Council (Public Health Department) have commissioned an Emotional Health and Wellbeing Survey for secondary schools in Derbyshire. This is the third year of the project.

The survey is called My Life, My View and is being delivered to Year 9 students this year with a follow up survey for current year 9 students when they reach year 10. The survey has been developed by The Training Effect, a provider of services to schools and councils across the UK.
