My Life, My View – Youth Well-Being Survey 2019

Derbyshire County Council (Public Health Departments) have commissioned an Emotional Health and Wellbeing Survey for secondary schools in Derbyshire. This is the fourth year of the project.

The survey is called My Life, My View and is being delivered to year 11 students. The survey has been developed by The Training Effect, a provider of services to schools and councils across the UK.

The project is about finding out young people's views on their emotional health and well-being; the things that worry them, how they cope with worries, their perceptions on their community and who they trust to speak to. The information gathered will be used to plan support services for young people.

All students currently in year 11 will be asked to complete a short survey (this is not mandatory) before the end of the academic year. The survey will be confidential and will ask them about their experience of a range of issues including Internet safety, friendships, alcohol and smoking.
