## Year 11 Prom 2019

We are delighted to inform you that the Year 11 Prom 2019 will be held at The Platinum Suite, Uttoxeter Racecourse, on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2019. The ticket price for this event is £36.00 and is payable via the ParentPay\* system.

We recognise what an important celebratory event this is, and would like to invite all of our Year 11 students to the Prom. However, we have set criteria, which students must adhere to, between the start of this term and their last day at the academy, including the examination period, in order to attend in June. The criteria is based on the following targets:

- **Attendance** - Students must have a minimum of 90% attendance
- **Standards** - Students must not receive more than 5 late marks or 5 uniform negatives
- **Behaviour** - Students must not receive any fixed term exclusions, no more than 2 isolations or no more than 10 negative behaviour events

Students that meet the above criteria will have earned the right to attend the Prom by following the academy's rules and expectations. We feel that the criteria put in place will not only mean they will go to the Prom, but will also help prepare students with some essential life skills needed for the world of work, college and university. Any student who does not meet the criteria above will be reviewed on an individual basis and a decision regarding their invitation will be made by the Pastoral and Leadership Teams.

Based on the data collected during last term, we know that the vast majority of our Year 11 students will have no problem meeting these targets, and sincerely hope that all students wishing to attend will have earned the right to do so. At QEGS, we like to acknowledge students, reward good behaviour and achievements and we are currently putting together a "VIP Prom Pass", which will offer students that exceed our expectations the chance to be entered into a draw to win a special reward either at the Prom or before.
