Peace and Conflict Keywords

<u>Keyword</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Peace	Living without violent conflict.
Conflict	When two or more ideas or beliefs are opposed to each other.
Forgiveness	When a person's wrongdoings are ignored to move a relationship forward.
Reconciliation	Rebuilding a relationship which has broken down due to conflict.
Terrorism	Any activities, which are carried out to cause fear (terror). These are usually violent.
War	Violent conflict, usually between two or more countries.
Retaliation	Using violence in response to someone else attacking you.
Greed	Being driven by a desire, usually for more land, money or power.
Holy War	When a War is fought as part of a person's religious beliefs. Usually under the instruction of a religious leader i.e. The Pope.
Just War	The belief that a War should only be fought if it sticks to certain rules to make it Just (fair/right).
Lesser Jihad	The Muslim belief that violent conflict should only be used in a Just way (i.e. Just War).
Greater Jihad	Dealing with an internal struggle (within yourself) to become a better Muslim. For example, giving up an addiction or ignoring temptation.
Pacifism	The belief that violence should never be used under any circumstances.
Weapon of Mass Destruction	Nuclear, Chemical or Biological weapons which cause destruction and/or death on a huge scale.
Mutually Assured Destruction (M.A.D)	The idea that a Nuclear War can only ever result in both sides being wiped out.
Nuclear Deterrent	The belief that a country should have Nuclear Weapons to deter (put off) another country from attacking them with Nuclear Weapons.
Quakers	A Pacifist Christian organisation.
Sanctity of Life	The belief that life is Holy and should always be protected
Justice	What is fair and right
