
GCE - Candidate statement of provisional results (CSoPR)




On results day, each student will have a candidate statement of provisional results. These will be accessible to schools/colleges through the Results 'e-Documents' section of e-AQA.

Our A-level Biology, Chemistry and Physics qualifications now have a practical skills endorsement which is shown on this statement under the main award. On this example it is shown highlighted in purple. Where a student sits more than one science with an endorsement element it will show as **[Practical Skills]** under each of the science main awards.

Reformed AS and A-levels are linear, so, we do not use uniform marks (UMS) and these are not displayed on the statement. Only the overall award grade will be shown. This is highlighted on the example in red.

For specifications that use uniform marks and for modular qualifications UMS will be available and shown highlighted in green.

GCSE



On results day, each student will have a candidate statement of provisional results (CSoPR). These will be accessible to schools/colleges through the Results 'e-Documents' section of e-AQA.

Reformed GCSEs with first awards in summer 2017 will use the new 9(nine) - 1(one) grade scale. These grades will be shown alongside any outgoing specifications using the $A^*(a^*) - G(g)$ grade scale.

GCSE English Language (8700) has a Spoken Language endorsement. The result for the endorsement element will show as either Pass, Merit, Distinction or Not Classified as highlighted in purple on the example above.

Reformed GCSEs are linear, so we do not use uniform marks (UMS) and these are not displayed on the statement. Only the overall award grade will be shown This is highlighted on the example in red.

For specifications that use uniform marks and for modular qualifications, UMS will be available and shown highlighted in green.
