Year 12 Independent Enquiry Field Work – 22nd October 2019 **Trip Leader – Ms Fisher**

A key component of the Geography A Level course is a unit entitled 'Independent Investigation' where all students must undertake a minimum of 4 days of fieldwork. This makes up **20% of the A Level course**. This year's fieldwork will involve students undertaking a one day trip to the Holderness coastline and a residential trip to follow in June 2020. We plan to take the students to Holderness on the 22nd October and hope to visit a range of sites from Flamborough Head to Spurn Point.

We will be leaving school at 8.50am and returning at approximately 8pm. Students will need to be appropriately dressed for fieldwork, which will be largely on the beach all day. They should bring a packed lunch, a small amount of money with them and waterproofs if they have them. We have a small supply of waterproofs that students can borrow from the department should they need to.

The cost of the trip is **£23.50** to cover the cost of transport and resources. Payment is required via ParentPay by Monday 7th October 2019.

The law does not allow us to make a charge for these, though we may ask for voluntary contributions. No student may be excluded from the activity because of a parent or carer's unwillingness or inability to make a financial contribution. However, unless the voluntary contributions cover the cost of the activity, it cannot go ahead.
