A key focus for our school is enabling our students to become more independent, and as such, there is a report aspect: 'Responsibility for Own Learning'. This is a challenging attribute, and as such it will be rarer for students to be given 'Exceeding Expectations'; in many cases students will start the year with 'Inconsistent' as they are starting to develop these skills and take on this responsibility.


At this stage of your child's time at QEGS, we believe that is important for them to focus on the Aspects of Learning, and answering the two questions:

- What can I do well?
- What do I need to do to improve?

Feedback in lessons (written and verbal) is focussed on these two questions, rather than the grade. At the end of this year, we will use information from internal assessments, alongside external data (Key Stage 2 results and Fischer Family Trust) to determine a 'Flightpath' for your child (Expected Grade at the end of Year 11).
