



PSHE Courses

ALL PSHE Options will require each student to carry out a presentation on the value, learning and impact of their option. This could be via English speaking assessment, form time, assembly, within the group activity and/or to a small audience of staff/governors similar to Futures award. The courses (except for those with a *) will be non examined but will enrich the student and prepare them further for life beyond school.

- Duke of Edinburgh Leaders – These students will carry out expeditions and will focus on communication, commitment, leadership and teamwork.
- Study Skills- These students will study learning sciences and explore the best ways to revise and prepare for examinations.
- Sports Leaders – These students will be leading primary sports events and developing leadership skills.
- Language Leaders – These students will be working with primary schools to develop MFL provision and develop their speaking and listening skills.
- Restore and Repair Leaders – These students will be taking on school and community projects to repair and restore resources/environment.
- Higher Project Qualification* –. The Higher Project qualification (HPQ) is a standalone qualification and can be taken by students as an addition to their **GCSE** or other Level 2 qualifications. The HPQ provides an exciting opportunity to conduct research into subjects which may not be available as part of other formal studies.
- Childcare Leaders* – These students will be studying Childcare as part of their option choices and will be on placement locally, developing knowledge and understanding for Level 2 qualification in 'real world' placement.
- Mentoring Leaders – These students will be developing mentoring skills to support younger students, planning and running projects for students to opt into and gain support and conducting reviews and surveys on students' needs
- Teaching Assistant Leaders – These students will be exploring interest in teaching and working with younger students either in lessons at QEGS or local primary schools
- Eco-Leaders – These students will be developing an eco-strategy for the school, taking on projects to reduce, recycle and re-use and promoting eco-priorities and holding events

Any student taking DART will be on their DART placement during these PSHE sessions.
