- On-going assessment – no exam

- It is a pass or fail course – there is no variation on grades.

- Five lessons per fortnight – teaching time
- Built in time into your timetable to support lessons/students
- An expectation that you will work as a reading mentor to y7/8 students (this will count towards your voluntary hours).
