

Y6 Transition Activities for Modern Foreign Languages at QEGS

1. Using objects around the house eg. lego, cutlery, clothes, spaghetti, marshmallows – literally whatever you can find, **build or create a model of the Eiffel Tower and/or the Arc de Triomphe** in Paris, France.
2. Enjoy a delicious **French breakfast** of croissants, pain au chocolat, pain aux raisins and/or make some tasty crêpes.
3. **Listen to a story or fairytale** in another language by looking on <https://www.thefablecottage.com> which is currently giving free access to their resources.
4. **Create the French or Spanish flag** by using the correct coloured objects from things around your home eg. clothes, towels, toys, books. You could even do a different French or Spanish speaking country eg. Mexico, Peru, Bolivia.
5. Learn how to **count to 12 with Sergio Agüero** by watching the video on the following link <https://www.bbc.co.uk/sport/av/football/53008783>
6. Watch an episode of **Pocoyo**, a Spanish cartoon, and write down the words that you learn. Find clips on Youtube. Here is an example: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KD1ofxSCRvQ>
7. Learn the Spanish or French numbers 1-30 with your family and then play **BINGO!** One family member calls the numbers out in Spanish or French and the rest listen and tick off on a homemade bingo grid.
8. Challenge yourself to complete a **tongue twister** in Spanish or French. Here are two examples:
Tres tristes tigres tragaban trigo en un trigal. (Spanish)
Cinq chiens chassent six chats. (French)
9. Make a Mexican inspired lunch by preparing some '**quesadillas**'. The main ingredients are cheese and a tortilla wrap. The filling consists of cheese (queso) with other items of your choice including ham, chicken, chorizo, pineapple, peppers, mushrooms. The fillings are folded into the wrap and cooked lightly in a frying pan.
