## **Co-curricular Sport**

QEGS PE department are delighted to now be able to offer co-curricular sport opportunities, starting Monday 2nd November, the timetable is attached. All students are welcome to take part in any of these opportunities and we welcome your support in encouraging and enabling your child to attend.

The morning multi-sport opportunity will rotate activities on a weekly basis between badminton, basketball, handball, table tennis and volleyball. These activities will run from 8am to 8.30am, all taking place in the sports hall or gym, and students will not need to wear PE kit to take part in these. All after school activities will start at 2.35pm and finish at 3.55pm, in the venue specified on the timetable, and students will need to come to school in their PE kit on that day if they wish to participate in these, as changing rooms are still not available.

PE kit expectations remain the same as for lessons and full details of these, along with how to order new kit, can be found on the uniform page of the 'At QEGS' section of the website. In brief, students are required to wear a QEGS branded PE top, plain black shorts/skort/leggings, red sports socks and suitable trainers/football boots, dependent on the activity.

Although we will have students from different year groups taking part in activities on the same evening, we want to assure you that all year groups will work separately, in their own space, using their own set of equipment for their year group. However, it is important that you are aware that students in Years 7, 8 and 9 will be working within their year group bubble during these activities, as opposed to their normal teaching group bubble. Years 10, 11, 12 and 13 already operate in year group bubbles, so this will be no different for them. All equipment will be disinfected after each session and we will follow the current National Governing Body Covid guidelines for each sport.

Please complete the permission slip attached, to indicate which co-curricular activities you consent to your child attending. To enable us to run effective track and trace procedures, students should hand these into the teacher responsible for running the activity, who will sign it and record your child's name on the register. If your son/daughter turns up to the practice but has not returned the permission slip they will be unable to participate and they will have to attend after school provision until they can get picked up. Copies of the permission slip are available from Form Tutors, if needed.
