GO 4 Schools – Latest Report Now Available

The latest report for your child is now available in GO 4 Schools. Reports and Progress data can be accessed via the GO 4 Schools website. <https://www.go4schools.com/parents>

The Year 13 report includes two grades:

- Your child's UCAS Prediction. This is the best grade we think they could achieve at the end of Year 13, and is used for UCAS applications. It takes into account a student's full potential, so in many cases this can be higher than the current predicted grade.
- A predicted grade. This is the most likely grade we think a student will achieve based on current assessment data.

Further information will be issued following the mock examinations and in March.
