Dear Parents, Carers and Students

¡Feliz Año Nuevo! Bonne Année! Frohes Neues Jahr! Happy New Year!

We hope this letter finds you safe and well. We want to be able to offer you as much support and guidance as we possibly can during the period of remote learning. We understand that remote learning a foreign language can be difficult and we would like to make the experience a positive and enjoyable one for all our students and families. Therefore, we have put together a bank of resources for you to be able to dip in and out of to both support and enhance remote language learning. The vast majority of our lessons will be delivered live by your child's class teacher, however, there will also be some pre-recorded lessons delivered via LOOM which your child will access during their lesson and the teacher will be available for support and feedback.

We recommend that where possible you try to engage in the learning process with your child. You don't need to be able to speak the language to do this! Please find below some activities and resources you might like to try.

Useful activities to support your child's language learning:

- 1. Go through a list of vocabulary with them. Ask your child to read the words aloud to you and practise the pronunciation. Your child could try memorising the words and then you could give them a quick quiz.
- 2. Ask your child to teach you the numbers 1-30 in a language and then play a family game of BINGO.
- 3. Ask your child to tell you about themselves in Spanish/French/German we are certain that you would love listening to them and it is a great way for them to practise some simple sentences in the comfort of their own environment. They should be able to say their name, their age, what they look like, things they like as a starting point.

Useful websites:

- 1. www.wordreference.com this is an online dictionary available in multiple languages. It can be useful to use to check the meanings of foreign words in a text or if students are writing a text and need to look up a word they know in English but aren't sure of in the target language.
- 2. www.linguascope.com Username: queeneli Password: pizza. This is a fun way to learn and consolidate vocabulary with lots of interactive games as well as some worksheets and vocabulary lists. We recommend Elementary Level for Year 7, Beginner for Year 8 and Year 9 and Intermediate for KS4 and KS5.
- 3. <u>www.languagesonline.org.uk</u> available in all three languages, this website is super for learning and consolidating vocabulary as well as a whole grammar section. There are lots of units which link in with our schemes of learning.
- 4. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/subjects/zrqmhyc BBC Bitesize offers reading and listening activities with short videos on a range of topics studied at QEGS. There are KS3 and KS4 areas to look at.
