Hagg Farm Residential – 9th June 2021

We are delighted to offer your child the opportunity to join us on a one-night residential trip to Hagg Farm on Wednesday 9th until Thursday 10th June 2021. The purpose of this trip is for our students to build on their employability skills and to support your child with the transition from Year 11 to their post-16 option.

Day 1

- Students will meet on the QEGS bus bay at 9am to register and then depart for 9.15am; we will be travelling with Glover Coaches.
- On arrival at Hagg Farm, we will be greeted by their staff who will run through the activities for the two days as well as a health & safety talk. Students will then take their bags to their assigned dorm room.
- Students will then take part in their first activity for the day followed by lunch (students to provide their own packed lunch for this day).
- After lunch students will then take part in their second activity followed by dinner. We will have campfires in the evening while discussing arrangements and next steps for their post-16/career journey.

Day 2

- Breakfast will be bright and early followed by further adventure activities throughout the day followed by lunch.
- Students will pack and depart from Hagg Farm at 4.30pm to arrive back at QEGS at 5.30pm.

The cost of this trip is £20 per student which can be paid via ParentPay*, the deadline for payments is **Friday 28th May 2021**. Please note that we can only allocate 36 places for this trip, so it will be a 'first come, first served' basis.
