## **Year 11 Transition Days 2021**

## **Transition Days: QEGS Sixth Form**

To support Year 11 in their transition to Sixth Form there will be a series of A Level and Level 3 BTEC preparation lessons offered live on Teams from Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 18<sup>th</sup> June. Students will be given a timetable with details of all sessions; it will be based on the usual timings of the school day, with lessons of 45 minutes, P1 9.00 / P2 10.05 / P3 11.05 / P4 12.25 / P5 13.25.

- Sessions may well be interactive and involve student participation e.g. breakout rooms, group discussions etc.
- Teachers may set research tasks for students to complete and bring to future sessions or the Year
   11 Transition Day session on 22<sup>nd</sup> June.
- Provide students with examples of how they can apply/relate your subject to the real world/current affairs.
- Use reading material to develop students' understanding of their subjects.
- Provide students with an overview of your subject specification, assessment structure and expectations.
- Some subjects may ask their students to attend in-person sessions so they can participate in a practical lesson. The location of the lesson will be confirmed in the invitation.

Subject teachers will send a Teams invitation to their sessions, based on the options selected by students. Designed to give an overview and insight into the content and scope of their chosen subject, students will be expected to attend and there will be follow-up to the sessions at the in-person Transition Day event on **Tuesday 22**<sup>nd</sup> **June**. All students will receive a blank timetable to complete with their chosen sessions.

If any student has limited technology access and needs to attend sessions in person, or any student who has online lessons and in-person lessons in the same day and needs space at school to cut down on travelling from distance or waiting for buses, please contact Mrs Thrupp,
