UNIVERSITIES & FURTHER EDUCATION COLLEGE VISITS INFORMATION

The purpose of the visits is to enable students to see a university and college, providing them with information about different further education opportunities. Students will be visiting Chesterfield College on Tuesday 20th July and Staffordshire University on Thursday 22nd July. Students will also be given the opportunity to experience a taster day at our QEGS Sixth Form. During each visit students will be given talks on entrance requirements, the range of courses on offer and a tour of the campus. There will also be an opportunity to visit different departments, speak to undergraduate students and experience taster sessions in their chosen subjects.

IN SCHOOL ACTIVITY INFORMATION

Students will be given advice on CVs, covering letters, and completing job application forms. They will be given advice on apprenticeships and will hear about university life from former QEGS students. There will also be a range of occupational talks given by representatives from industry and local businesses. Students will attend five talks based

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on their areas of interest. Finally, students will practise their interview skills in a mock interview with one of the employer representatives.

Due to the cost of transport and activities at White Hall, a voluntary contribution of **£50** via **ParentPay*** will be required. This will cover the cost of all visits. If costs are not met the trips may not take place, which would be disappointing. The law currently allows us to make no charge for this category of educational activity, though we may ask for voluntary contributions. No student may be excluded from the activity because of a parent's unwillingness or inability to make a financial contribution. If you want your child to attend, but are unable to meet the cost, please contact finance@qegs.email. **The deadline for trip payment will be Monday 5th July 2021.**

Students will need to bring a packed lunch for the trips and are required to wear school uniform. The visits will take place during the school day and students will return in time to catch buses home except for the trip to White Hall. These activities & visits will raise students' awareness of the variety of Post-16 pathways available to them and will enable them to make an informed choice in Year 11 and to enhance their employability skills.
