## GO 4 Schools – Latest Report Now Available

The latest report for your child is now available in GO 4 Schools. Reports and Progress data can be accessed via the GO 4 Schools website (not the app). You should see a link at the top of the page saying there is a new report. If that is not there, scroll down to the bottom to 'Progress and Reports', and then 'View Report'.

This Year 13 report includes three grades:

- Your child's UCAS Prediction. This is the best grade we think they could achieve at the end of Year 13, and is used for UCAS applications. It takes into account a student's full potential, so in many cases this can be higher than the current predicted grade.
- Their external target. This is based on their average points score at the end of Key Stage 4 (Year 11).
- A current predicted grade. This is the most likely grade we think a student will achieve based on current assessment data.

Further reports will be issued in February (including mock grades) and April. Students get regular feedback in lessons to answer the two questions 'What am I doing well?' and 'What do I need to do to improve?', but please do contact your child's subject teacher, form tutor, Mr Walker or Mrs Thrupp if you would like further information.
