Relaxed but not casual. Taking everything in his stride, a great team player, there to offer support to anyone who needs it. A fantastic traveller and travelling companion.

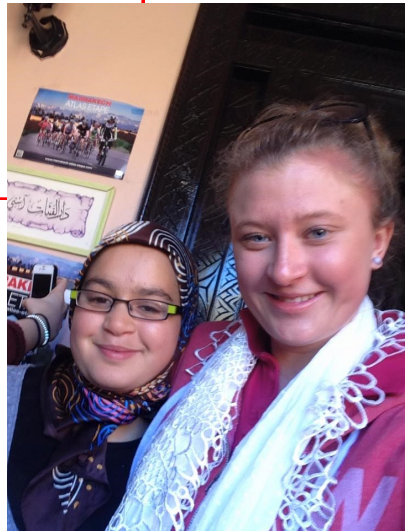


Abi: The Snow White Award

Suffered with a cough and cold all week, but never moaned once. Always had a smile on her face, a great traveller with lots of energy. Hidden talents in 1980's dance moves.

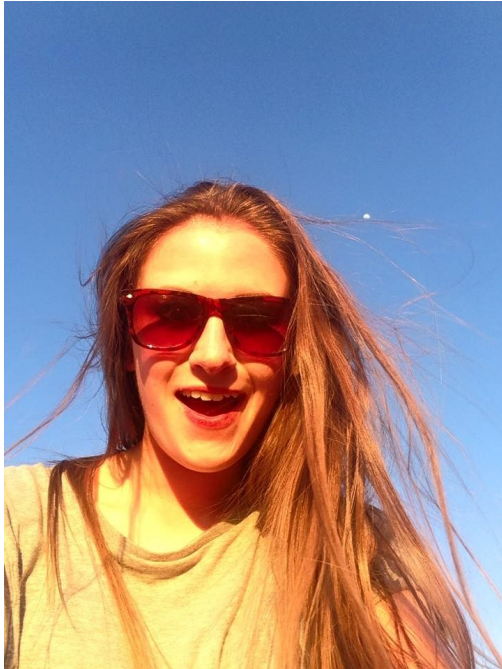


Ben: Wanton killing of young goats award.

One of the most social and caring students. Always there for others when needed and always with a smile on her face. For a tall woman her nasal vessels need to get better at coping with altitude.

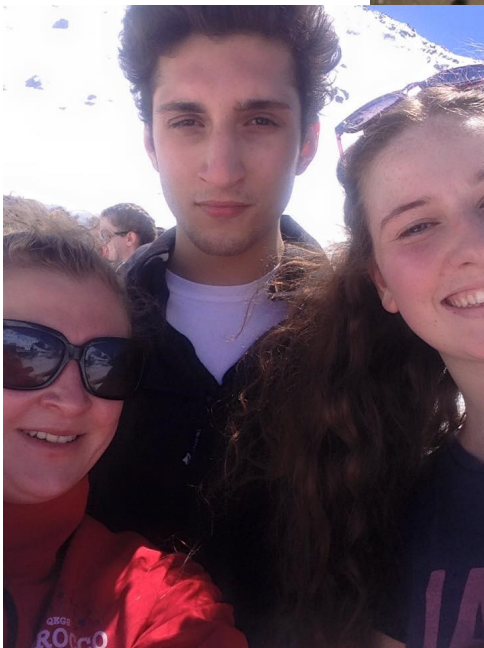
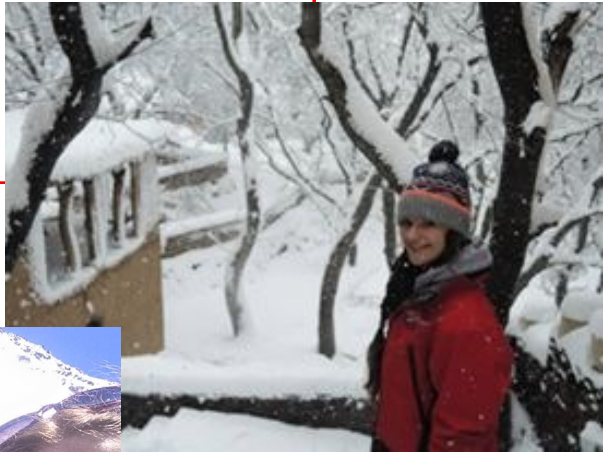


Frankie: The Onion Award for layers of skin
