#### Evacuation on Wednesday 24th November 2021

I am sure you are aware that on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> November we had a whole school, unplanned evacuation during the middle of the school day. Our well-rehearsed safety and evacuation plans were put to the test and I am pleased to say that all of our students and staff remain safe and well. I am also very proud of the students' behaviour and the staff calmness during the process. We would not be open today if the site was in any way unsafe. So please be reassured all is fine, we continue to be ready and alert to any danger and we will always act with caution if required.

I appreciate that there will be lots of questions for detail. However, at this stage I am not able to share any information due to an ongoing police investigation. What disappoints and concerns me is that in the absence of facts and school communication, some students have created rumours which relate to fellow students and our staff. Some of the rumours we have been made aware of are particularly hurtful. Sharing the rumour in some ways is just as hurtful and as damaging as making it up. Please talk to your child about the risks and impact of gossip and rumours in such a close-knit community.

To help remove specific areas of speculation and doubt, I can confirm that the danger and subsequent investigation did not and does not, involve any of our students or our staff. The police have also commended the school and our staff for their swift action.

Please reassure your child that we have drills and safety procedures for the rare occasion when they are needed. They should always do as they did on Wednesday: stay calm and quiet, listen to staff instructions, follow their well-rehearsed routines and always alert staff to any concerns they may see or hear.
