## GO 4 Schools – Latest Report Now Available

The latest report for your child is now available in GO 4 Schools. Reports and Progress data can be accessed via the GO 4 Schools website. <https://www.go4schools.com/parents>

This Year 12 report includes two grades:

- A predicted grade. This is the most likely grade we think a student will achieve at the end of Year 13 based on current assessment data.
- An external target. This is based on their Average Points Score (APS) at the end of Year 11, across the GCSE and vocation qualifications.

Later in the year we will add your child's UCAS Prediction. This is the best grade we think they could achieve at the end of Year 13 and is used for UCAS applications. It takes into account a student's full potential, so in many cases this can be higher than the current predicted grade.

Timetable, homework, behaviour, and attendance data can be viewed on both the website and the mobile app (available for smartphones and tablet). Your child can also access this information via <https://www.go4schools.com/students>
