


Maths Problem of the Week.

Travelling on Derbyshire School Transport

Thank you to students, who pay correctly for each journey on the school bus routes. Unfortunately, reports from some bus drivers recently that some students not eligible for a bus pass, are trying to travel without paying £1 per journey to the bus driver on Derbyshire School routes. Failure to do so may mean travel is refused that day and/or for longer periods.

Students with a bus pass, should make sure their pass is clearly visible to the driver along with the route number (no stickers covering). Using a bus pass issued to another student or lending your bus pass to another student may result in your pass being withdrawn by Derbyshire School Transport.

If you have lost your bus pass, please speak to Student Services to order a new one (£5) and you will be issued with a temporary pass.

Public bus routes require students to pay the bus service's regular fare unless a bus pass has been issued for the route. A B-Line card can be used for travel discount on routes.

If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals or you feel financially you will not be able to meet the full costs of travel, please contact Mrs K Starkie, Assistant Headteacher and our Pupil Premium lead via email starkiek@qegs.email to see if assistance is available.
