Duke of Edinburgh's Award – 2022 Expedition kit return Trip Award Leader – Ms Watson Jones

Firstly, I would like to say a huge well done and thank you to all of the Bronze and Silver participants. It has been a pleasure to take them out this year and they have all been fantastic! They have made me a proud DofE Manager, and I hope both yourselves and your child are proud of their efforts too!

Secondly, I would also like to thank you all as parents/carers for your support with drop offs/pickups/organising correct equipment etc. Without your support, we can not run these programs, so a big thank you from me!!

## What happens next?

- 1. Please make sure that tent's have been aired out completely (even if they may have seemed dry packing them away!). This is to ensure they do not go mouldy between now and next year. If the tent is very dirty (or had not been aired by time this letter gets to you, please put just the inner on a gentle wash with no laundry powder).
- 2. Kit needs to be returned.

Your child has signed out/taken responsibility for certain parts of equipment, and this now needs to be returned in a clean and working order. All parts of the Trangia should be clean and dry. The tent should be dry, clean and separated into parts ready for checking. Any first aid equipment used, please replenish (i.e. blister pads – please let me know if you are not able to do this).

During these time slots, your group will be asked to bring your equipment to the Level 2 corridor. Students will be asked to take out all equipment and have it checked back in by myself or other staff members. Please note: students should NOT leave equipment by the DofE store room, it must be checked in by a member of staff first! If your child cannot attend their groups allocated session please let me know.

3. Time to finish off Skills/Physical/Volunteering sections and submit on eDofE.
