GO 4 Schools – Latest Progress Data Now Available

Today we are publishing reports for your child in GO 4 Schools. For Year 7, for the first time you will see a Flight path and current predicted grade band for each subject, 3>5 or 4>6:

- The Flight path is the grade band we expect they **could** achieve at the end of Year 11 and is based upon both an external target (from Fischer Family Trust) and internal assessment during Year 7.
- The Current Predicted Grade is the most likely grade band that we believe they **would** achieve based on current assessment data.

We use GCSE grades for predictions and flight paths from Years 7-11, but band these grades in Year 7. We want our students to focus on getting better in every subject during key stage 3 rather a focus on single GCSE grades.

We understand that this is very early in your child's time at QEGS, and both of these grade bands may change over time. We do make changes based on teacher evidence (including classwork and assessments), in discussion with the Curriculum Leader for each subject.
