Safeguarding Information - Nitrous Oxide- Laughing Gas

Nitrous oxide is a colourless gas that is most commonly found in pressurised metal canisters. You may have seen these metal canisters lying around in streets or parks.



It is becoming increasingly popular with young people in the UK and is readily available to buy online. Laughing gas is often categorised as a 'legal high' but if someone takes too much nitrous oxide, they risk falling unconscious and/or suffocating from the lack of oxygen.

It is a good idea for you to talk about this with your children to ensure they understand the levels of risk, how best to stay safe – and how to look after their friends too.

Stay calm and open-minded when you talk to your child about drugs.
