UK University & Apprenticeship Search Fair – Leicester King Power Stadium, Friday 7<sup>th</sup> October 2022

We hope our Year 12 students have had a positive and enjoyable start to the term so far and that they have settled into Sixth Form life. As the academic year progresses, we will be talking to our year 12 students about their future options and career plans. As part of this, we will introduce all students to the fantastic opportunities available at both university and via the apprenticeship route. To assist them with making decisions about these opportunities, we would like to take the whole of Year 12 to a UK University and Apprenticeship Fair in Leicester on **Friday 7th October.** 

The exhibition will provide attendees with the opportunity to speak to a multitude of exhibiting universities and apprenticeship providers including the Russell Group as well as red brick and modern institutions all in one place. If students have questions, they can speak to the various representatives and collect leaflets etc. Whether they just want to confirm their ideas, or if they have no idea where to start, this convention will give them some answers.
