

In the current economic climate, it is more important than ever to check if help is available through Free School Meal checker to support you and your child at school. If you child is in receipt of FSM - breakfast is available in the canteen before school from 8.15am. For FSM students they can help themselves to a slice of toast/fruit and a bottle of water and Rm 540 to collect snacks before start of school day, plus snacks for break can be collected from their Progress Leader's office.

The school meal deal is available to all FSM children each day and is the best value for money for the £2.60p allowance - hot dinner, dessert and a bottle of water.
