## Arrangements for Year 11 during the mocks

- Breakfast will be available in the hall before form time each day
- Each morning students will go to either the hall (if they have an exam at 9am) or their form room to register and then to the location shown on the timetable. For most exams this is the Main Hall
- Break and lunchtimes will be at the same time as usual.
- Where there are two exams in the same slot (for example triple and combined science exams) students sitting the shorter exam will stay in the sports hall, and will need to bring revision resources with them for remaining time.


For those students who are eligible for access arrangements, Mr Bembridge (SENCO) will contact them after half term to explain the arrangements and confirm the location for their exams (in the hall or an alternative location).

As for the core mocks at the start of October, we will run this examination session following the rules that apply for external exams wherever possible, including:

- No mobile phones, iPods, MP3s, MP4s or watches are to be taken into any examination. All wrist wear, including watches, bracelets etc. should be removed and placed on the desk in clear view.
- No food, sweets or chewing gum allowed in any examination. Students may bring a drink (water only) in a clear plastic bottle with a screw top and label removed.
- Students must bring appropriate equipment with them to all examinations. This includes pens, pencils, eraser, ruler and calculator (if allowed). The equipment should be in a clear pencil case or a clear plastic bag. Please note that there are no calculators available to be handed out in the exam hall.
- Students should follow instructions from staff on where to line up, ready to go into the Sports Hall and find their designated seat.
- Students are not permitted to communicate with each other whilst in the Sports Hall during examination times.
- If students are not in a timetabled exam, they will be in lessons as normal.
