### Year 10 and 11 Voluntary Contributions

The economic climate we are experiencing is challenging and will pose challenges for families, schools and all sectors of the national and indeed global economy. We know things will be tough and money tight and this letter is simply a request for your support as we move into the year to see if you can and we respectfully accept you may not be able to at present.

This letter serves two purposes:

- To outline our curriculum provision for Years 10 and 11 and request for associated voluntary contributions.
- To outline our plans for improving provision of facilities and resources at QEGS.

#### Year 10 and 11 curriculum provision and voluntary contributions

During the course of Year 10 and 11 your child will be provided with numerous school resources including a student planner, key text books for their courses in English, Maths, Science, History or Geography and Religious Studies.

Rather than ask for multiple small amounts of voluntary contributions from core departments over the course of the year, we have established an amount, which covers these costs. **We are seeking a voluntary contribution of £10.00**. Your contribution will be spent directly on the curriculum and on providing good quality materials and equipment to enable students to develop a wide range of skills.

## Improving facilities and resources at QEGS

Despite the financial challenges all schools will face, we will continually seek to improve our facilities and resources at QEGS. We are fortunate to have had secure finances for a number of years and our sports, technological, scientific, artistic and performance resources are some of the best in the area. However, we are not complacent and we aspire to have high quality facilities so that students can excel in their areas of interest. You may well have seen a number of stories in the local and national press and on television about school funding recently and will therefore be aware that the current situation is extremely tough. Your help and financial support would certainly go some way to help the school and benefit the students. Thank you for your support during 2021/22, we were able to purchase a new bike shelter, some additional outside seating for students and new technology equipment. To support new facilities and resources such as outside seating, ICT and sports equipment we are seeking a voluntary contribution of £8.00.

We must stress both amounts are contributions and are entirely voluntary, students will not be disadvantaged if you unable to support this request.

If you feel able to contribute, payments are requested through our online payments system ParentPay and are most gratefully received. Contributions can be made in one lump sum or in smaller amounts over the course of the year. In addition to this, we would ask if you are able to complete and return the attached gift aid declaration. This will enable us to claim an additional 25p for every pound you have donated.
