## **Student Sickness During the School Day**

If your child becomes ill during the school day they must ask a member of staff if they can go to the medical room so that they can be assessed and parents will then be contacted. Arrangements may then be made for them to be collected from student services by a family member or relative. **Students are not to use their own mobile phones to arrange this**. This is in line with our safeguarding procedure.

## **Derbyshire School Bus routes**

This week school has received messages from a couple of school bus companies' reference to students not paying for travel as they get onto the bus if student is not eligible for a free bus pass/home address out of QEGS catchment area. **The bus driver will refuse travel to/from school if payment is not made** – it is £1 per journey, exact money please paid to the driver as students get on. If students have lost their bus pass and is eligible for a free pass, please speak to Student Services who can organise a replacement (£5 for routes except 009 bus pass - £15). Students using public buses without a free bus pass must pay the fare set by the public bus company.

## School uniform 'Pop-up Shop' – Wednesday 7th December – 3.30 to 5pm

Opportunity to make sure your child is ready for January 2023 return to school – the Schools In pop-up shop will be in the school Canteen on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> December from 3.30pm. If your child is eligible for free school meals, this also means they are eligible for Pupil Premium support in school to help with purchasing school uniform (<u>https://www.queenelizabeths.derbyshire.sch.uk/learning/pupil-premium/</u>) – this includes a uniform bundle once a year – if you have not used this opportunity yet this year and would like to, please drop Mrs Starkie an email prior to the shop visiting school (<u>starkiek@qegs.email</u>) or your child's Progress Leader.

Well done to the Year 10 rugby team who won the u15 Derbyshire schools rugby tournament!




The final Primary event of 2022 was held today- year 3 & 4 basketball. Well done to everyone that took part and a big thank you to our sports leaders for running the event.
