Duke of Edinburgh's Award - Year 9 Bronze Award Expedition Online and In school Training

I hope you have all had a restful festive break! I want to take this opportunity to touch base about the Bronze DofE Award and what will be happening over the coming months.

Where should your child be up to at the moment?

Most participants have now logged on to eDofE and set up their program planners, and are well underway with their skills/physical/volunteering sections.

I have emailed a number of students who have not yet done this – I would be very grateful if you could check your child has completed their program planners, and if not, they must come to a drop in session on Thursday lunchtimes in 557.

NEXT STEPS: Online Training

As the Expedition dates are getting closer it is now time for the Bronze Award students to start their pre-expedition training. The majority of the pre-expedition training is completed via the e-learning link; www.richadventure.co.uk/qegs2023

The password to enter this is DofE2023. Students must then register an account on the website. Further details on how to do this are available on the BRONZE DOFE TEAMS.

This Rich Adventure Landing page has lots of useful information for both students and parents (including another copy of the kit list, dates of expeditions and eventually there will be locations too).

This e-learning must be completed by Wednesday 26th April AND the consent form must also be completed.

COMING UP SOON: In Person Training Afternoons

There will be 2 separate afternoons of in person training: Wednesday 22nd March 2023 and Wednesday 3rd May 2023.

The meeting place for this will be the canteen at 2.15pm and will be led by myself and Mrs Wright. These sessions are compulsory and should your child not be able to attend there will be very little opportunity available to undertake this training at other times before the Expeditions.

Students will be required to bring in their waterproof coats and trousers, as well as walking boots for checking on Wednesday 22nd March 2023 (and tent if they are using their own).

Students will be bringing equipment home on Wednesday 3rd May so a lift home for students where possible may be appreciated.
