Dear Parent/Carer,

At Queen Elizabeth's Grammar School, we pride ourselves on having high standards of presentation and uniform and ask for the continued co-operation of students, parents and carers in maintaining these.

We ask all of our students to attend school in full uniform. We absolutely understand that there are rare occasions which result in uniform not being worn in full, but ask that this is always communicated with the school in advance of your child arriving that day so that pastoral teams are aware and can support with providing correct uniform if needed.

Wearing our uniform is an important part of establishing pride in, and identifying with, Queen Elizabeth's Grammar School's rich and extensive history. As a school we are therefore keen to support families who are finding the purchasing of uniform a challenge through accessing our uniform bundles. In order to support families when purchasing uniform, we have included some examples as a guide but would ask that parents/carers contact year teams if you have questions ahead of a purchase where you are unsure.

Uniform Expectations

School Blazer - School grey blazer, with school badge.

School Branded Tie

Trousers - Black, formal long trousers. Only smart plain tailored black trousers, no jeans or jean style, denims, leggings or casual trousers.

Skirt - School uniform, 'castle tartan' knee-length skirt (see photo)

Shirt/Blouse - White Collared Shirt

Socks/tights - Plain black

Shoes - Plain black lace-up or slip-on shoe/boot in a formal style. Please note that trainers are not permitted (inc plain black trainers e.g. Nike Air and Vans).

Coats (not compulsory) It is recommended that students have an appropriate winter coat or rain jacket for the colder months of the year.

Coats are **not** to be worn in class during lessons and should not include any imagery, logos or patterns that may be considered inappropriate or would bring the school into disrepute.

Hats – Baseball caps are not permitted in the school building.

Jewellery - Students may wear a watch on their wrist, and one small stud in each ear. No other jewellery is permitted. Only a small, flat, fully clear retainer may be worn in the nose. No metal, sparkling, coloured studs, or nose rings please. We will ask students to remove any piercings which are not in line with this.

Hair - Hairstyles should not be extreme.












School PE Kit



- QEGS PE rugby shirt or polo shirt
- QEGS PE or plain red mid-layer
- QEGS PE mid-thigh length skort, PE shorts or plain black tracksuit bottoms or plain black leggings
- Red sports socks or white or black ankle socks;
- Trainers & football boots.
- Shinpads
- Gum shield

Please note that hoodies are *not* part of school uniform and should not be worn. However, if students want to bring an additional layer, to wear during their PE lesson, this can consist of the mid-layer option, a plain black sweatshirt or a plan black shower proof jacket, for outdoor activities.

Jumpers & Sweaters

A deep V-neck, shallow V-neck or round neck plain black jumper is allowed under the QEGS blazer.

Please note, if students wear a jumper for school, they must *also* wear the school blazer. The jumper is not permitted in place of the blazer.





No Logos of any kind either on the front, back, arms or collars/cuffs of the jumper or sweater. No zip tops or folding collars to be worn as a jumper under the blazer

Equipment Expectations



ID Cards and Lanyards

ID Cards and Lanyards must be worn at all times for year group identification and access to each education block.

The lanyards and ID badges also support our safeguarding of all students in school. We can easily identify our students and any staff and visitors to site.

QEGS staff have the staff grey lanyard.

Any visitors who have undergone safeguarding checks and shown identification/ evidence at reception of this, wear a **green lanyard** when on site.

All visitors with **red lanyards** are escorted by a member of the QEGS staff when on site. Anyone without a lanyard will be challenged by staff.

Compliance and Availability

Where a student does not meet the uniform expectation and there are no extenuating circumstances:

The uniform card is signed and the student asked to correct their uniform.

After 3 signatures the student serves an after school detention.

If there is further refusal or/and offers of support to correct the uniform are refused, the student will be directed to the 'Reset' room until the uniform is corrected.
