# **Final Day of Term Trips and Activities**

On 21<sup>st</sup> July we have 5 off site trips available. All are open to all year groups on a first come first served basis. The payment will be open at 5pm on 21<sup>st</sup> June.

For students who choose not to go on the trips, school will be 'off timetable' and departments will be offering a number of in school activities. These will be available free of charge. All activities are non uniform but appropriate clothing must be worn, no crop tops, short shorts or skirts.

#### Option 1 – Wildpark

The whole day at Wildpark paintballing. Returning prior to school bus departures. More balls can be purchased on the day, see their website for details. Strong footwear and suitable clothing including long sleeves and trousers required and bring a packed lunch.
