Maths

The maths mock exam is on **Tuesday 15th November**. The paper is 1 hour and 30 minutes long and is a **calculator paper** so please make sure you have the correct equipment with you for this.

2 x 50 minute exams, to keep them within an hour in line with all of your other subjects.

English Language

You will have a Q4 and Q5 from a Paper 2 English Language paper. This is the non-fiction paper and insert will have 2 sources with it. You are to use both of these sources to write a comparison response for Q4. You will then have the writing task to complete which will be a letter, speech, or article within which you have to persuade/present your point of view on a given topic. Spend 25 minutes on each task.

You will be expected to write a short introduction, one PETAL paragraph using the extract and one about another part of the play/novella. Spend 25 minutes on each task.


