

Some really big classes last weekend with 32 riders in the 80cm and 50 in the 90cm show jumping class, with school teams travelling from North Yorkshire, Buckinghamshire, Oxfordshire to compete for the National qualifier places.

Ava May Y won the 70cm class so is County Champion and qualifies for County Champs at Hickstead in May and National Championship in October.

The **009** bus route will have a new operator from Monday **15**th April **2024**; De-luxe Coaches.
