QEGS PE Update

Medals for QEGS Students at the Derbyshire County Swimming Championships.

Congratulations to our QEGS students who recently competed at the Derbyshire County Swimming Championships. The annual event, where the top swimmers from across the whole of Derbyshire compete, took place over 2 weekends. Elena A (Year 12), Connie H (Year 9), Daniel M (Year 8), Isabella M (Year 10), Jacob B (Year 7) and Jess W (Year 9) all qualified through many hours of training and determination at Ashbourne & District Swimming Club. Every swimmer achieved new PB's, plus Daniel M was awarded the overall 2nd place silver medal for 14yrs 400m IM and also overall 3rd place bronze medal for 14yrs 200m butterfly. Isabella M was awarded overall 2nd place silver medal for 16yrs 200m breaststroke.

Ashbourne & District Swimming Club is currently welcoming new members, catering to all levels of swimmers, for fitness, social, or competitive swimming.

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Derbyshire School Transport Routes

It has been brought to school's attention following the change of provider for the 009 route this week the incorrect amount has been charged since the increase was implemented in September 2023. Students who pay for travel (out of natural catchment/Post-16 students) should be paying £1.20 per journey. The previous provider allowed students to travel paying £1 per journey which was incorrect since the increase.

Please make sure your child has the correct money for each journey as travel may be refused if correct money is not paid to the driver. - Wednesday after school GCSE Further Maths with Ms Vora (invite only).



Year 11 CGSE

We are getting nearer to the first maths exam and it is crucial that all students are not only engaging in lessons but also finding time to do some work outside of lessons. Year 11 maths teachers will be sharing a power point with useful tips and resources on how to revise, including a reminder of the revision sessions we offer and key information about the exam dates. Included within this information will be a suggested topic list for revision alongside codes for SPARX which correlate directly to the topics.

Homework

All students in Years 7 – 11 have access to SPARX which is an online homework platform. Tasks are set weekly for students, and it is an expectation that students log in each week and attempt the tasks set. Every student was issued with an additional A5 exercise book to record their answers to the questions they attempt. If students are struggling with access to electronic devices, they may use the library at break and lunch times or after school where there are laptops available. There is also a drop-in maths help session on a Tuesday straight after school in room 318. Please can you encourage your children to engage with this as it is proven to help improve students' progress.

Year 10-11 Revision Guide Ordering Via the ParentPay Shop

Revision guides are available to order at discounted prices through the Parent Pay Shop on the school website: https://app.parentpay.com/ParentPayShop/Uniform/Default.aspx?shopid=7712

Orders are placed once a month by the Pastoral Team and your child will be notified when orders arrive in school e.g. if you order on the 10th May via the shop, the order will be placed first week of June. If your child receives Free School Meals, they can also receive free revision guides - please email/speak to your Form Tutor to order guides. For Maths and Science revision guides it is a good idea to check with your subject teacher to check whether ordering Triple, Foundation or Higher options of guides.
