Please note it is **compulsory for our Year 7, 8 and 9 students to wear a QEGS blazer**. A QEGS branded black V-neck jumper is optional to wear underneath the blazer.

It is **optional for our Year 10 and 11 students to wear a blazer**. **Should they choose not to wear a blazer, a QEGS branded black V-neck jumper is compulsory**. No other black jumpers will not be allowed come September 2024.

Any existing plain black sweatshirts that students own can still be used for PE lessons.

- To show that they are safe, through the presence of the year group coloured lanyard and ID Card.
