# **RULES**

Entrants should be prepared to introduce their own piece of music and their programme must consist of no more than one piece of music per class

Entrants may, if they wish, perform in both Vocal and Instrumental classes

Vocal entrants should be aware that the quality of lyrics is important and should only select a song suitable for a family audience

Entrants may be accompanied by a single instrument in sympathy with their performance, or may use a backing track which should be sent to Linda Perry Smith beforehand.

Entrants must bring their own accompanist and a piano is available at the venue. Anyone struggling to find an accompanist should contact Linda Perry Smith

Entrants must provide a copy of their music for the Adjudicator

The St Oswald's Church Hall will be open from 1pm on the day for practice or rehearsal, (e.g. to run through on the piano / test the acoustic) if required, pls let Linda PS know.

The competition organisers will be solely responsible for designing the order of the competition. More detailed timings will be given once all entries are in.

If circumstances permit, there may opportunities for contestants to perform in relevant local Rotary events over the school year, and possibly to be put forward to enter the Rotary District Concert on 25<sup>th</sup> January. As far as we are aware, there are no further heats in our District for the National Rotary Young Musician Competition this year.

You are welcome to bring family to support you, but please stay for the whole class. Ideally participants attend the whole event please, as the Overall Winner Cup will be announced and presented at the end
