Dear Parents and Carers

GO 4 Schools – Year 7 reports now available.

Today we have published reports for your child in GO 4 Schools, with book check grades and scores for each of the 3Rs: Respectful, Responsible and Ready to Achieve, where 1 is the highest. The guide below explains each of the scores:

Report Key	
Classwork	The teacher rating for book/classwork
Respectful	Students are polite, positive and patient.
Ready To Achieve	Students have high aspirations, participate in school life and show perseverance.
Responsible	Students are prepared, punctual and well-presented.

Blue	Classwork always shows commitment to learning and presentation
Green	Classwork mostly shows commitment to learning and presentation
Amber	Classwork rarely shows commitment to learning and presentation
Red	Classwork never shows commitment to learning and presentation
NR	Not relevant

Always	Your child is always polite, positive and patient - well done!
Mostly	Your child is polite, positive and patient most of the time.
Sometimes	Sometimes your child is disrespectful and their behaviour disrupts learning.
Rarely	Your child's disrespectful behaviour disrupts learning often - this is a cause for concern.
X	Not Present/Relevant
Ready To Achieve	
Always	Your child has high aspirations, participates and perseveres all of the time - well done!
Mostly	Your child has high aspirations, participates and perseveres most of the time.
Sometimes	There are times when your child does not try their best or they give up too easily.
Rarely	Your child's lack of effort, participation or perseverance is a cause for concern.

Responsible	
Always	Your child is always prepared, punctual and well-presented - well done!
Mostly	Your child is prepared, punctual and well-presented most of the time.
Sometimes	Sometimes your child is unprepared, late to lessons or not wearing the correct uniform.
Rarely	Your child is often unprepared, late to lessons or not wearing the correct uniform.
X	Not Present/Relevant

At this stage of your child's time at QEGS, we believe that is important for them to focus on the Aspects of Learning, and answering the two questions:

- What can I do well?
- What do I need to do to improve?



In the final report of the year, the report will include two grades:

- Target – the grade we expect they could achieve at the end of Year 11 this is calculated by Fischer Family Trust and is based on Key Stage 2 and/or CATS data)
- Prediction - the most likely grade that we believe they would achieve based on current assessment data
- In years 7 to 9 the grades are banded, for example 3>5 or 6>8.

In January, students will be given paper copies of their reports, which they will bring home, and tutors will explain the grades and ask students to answer some questions about them. Please do take the opportunity to discuss these with your child at home.
