Year 13 Student Finance Presentation - Tuesday 27th February





WORLD BOOK DAY COMPETITIONS 2025

Not just one, but two chances to win a prize!

The first one is a **READING** competition.

Read a library book that features a different country to our own and then write a postcard featuring details of the book.

This could be a fiction book, and the postcard could be from one of the characters in the story or a witness to the events.

Or it could be non-fiction, and the postcard could be a news report or written by a visiting tourist.



The second one is a **WRITING** competition.

Invent your own Mythological Creature and tell us all about it.

Tell us the name of your creation, what it looks like, where it came from and where it lives now. What motivates your creature, what personality traits does it have, and does it possess any magical powers?

You can include a small drawing of your creature, but the writing is the part that will (hopefully) earn the prize. *(No more than 2 sides of A4 paper)*

Entries for both competitions must be handed in to the library before the end of the day on

Friday 28th February 2025.

The prizes will be awarded after the half term holiday. Ask for more details or help with your book choice in the library.
