

Working in partnership with Sheffield Hallam University, we are delighted to inform you that our Year 12 students will be attending a day at university to experience lectures, workshops, meet students and tour the campus. The day will be a valuable introduction to the work we will begin in the summer term, covering applying to university and degree apprenticeships.

The trip will take place on Thursday 1st May 2025
