Tailor-Made Post-Half-Term Plan for Year 11 Students

We recognise that every Year 11 cohort is different. With that in mind, we have designed a **bespoke provision specifically for this year's group**, tailored to their unique strengths, needs, and feedback. This personalised approach is something we are committed to continuing with future cohorts, as we believe each group deserves a plan that reflects who they are.

Attached, you will find the schedule for the **first two weeks back after the half-term break**. This plan has been created to offer a balance of flexibility and focused support as students approach their final exams.

Here's how it works:

- **Green-highlighted sessions** are compulsory. These represent lessons for subjects where the final exam has not yet taken place. These sessions will include **targeted exam booster lessons**, and we expect all students to attend.
- **Yellow-highlighted sessions** offer flexibility. During these times, students **may choose to study at home** if they feel this will best support their preparation. However, should they wish to remain in school during these periods, they are very welcome to do so. In this case, they should attend their normal timetabled lessons, where teachers will be available to support with revision.

To help us manage this process effectively and ensure we maintain the highest standards of student welfare, we kindly ask that you complete the **Microsoft Form** below to indicate whether you are happy for your child to take study leave during the yellow-highlighted sessions. **This is essential for safeguarding purposes**, as it allows us to accurately monitor who should be on site at any given time.

Additionally, if a student chooses to study at home **after a morning exam or revision session**, they will need to **sign out at the designated area outside the main hall** before leaving the school site.
