Race 4 Life 2025: Friday 11th July

The Year 12 Business BTEC group are holding and organising the annual Cancer Research Fun Run on the QEGS fields and surrounding areas. The event will take place on Friday 11th of July 2025. We are raising money for Cancer Research UK. Please find the plan timings of the day are below.

What to wear?

We would ask that all students participating to wear their QEGS PE kit on the day with the choice of optional pink and blue accessories to add on to the outfit. Please ensure that any accessories added to the PE kit are appropriate as you will be running and ensure you have suitable footwear on the day.

All belongings will be stored in a locked classroom in the Sixth Form building. You will then head to the Pavillion and complete the warm before the race begins. Once you have completed your two laps of the course, you will be rewarded with a Race 4 Life medal or flower and then have 20-30 minutes to visit stalls, use the inflatables and refuel using the food stalls. You will then head back to your lessons and continue your day as normal before the next year group arrives.
