Spiritual Development:

- <u>Reflection and Self-Awareness</u>: Encouraging students to reflect on their own beliefs, values, and experiences, and to understand the beliefs of others.
- <u>Curiosity and Wonder</u>: Cultivating a sense of curiosity and wonder, fostering a willingness to explore new ideas and perspectives.
- <u>Creativity and Imagination</u>: Providing opportunities for students to express themselves creatively and to use their imagination to explore different ideas.

Moral Development:



- Recognising Right and Wrong: Helping students understand the concepts of right and wrong, respect for the law, and the consequences of their actions.
- <u>Ethical Reasoning</u>: Developing students' ability to identify and discuss moral and ethical issues, and to form reasoned opinions.
- Respect for Others: Promoting respect for different viewpoints and fostering tolerance and understanding of diverse cultures and beliefs.

Social Development:

- <u>Community Involvement</u>: Engaging students in community projects and activities, fostering a sense of belonging and social responsibility.
- <u>Cooperation and Teamwork</u>: Encouraging collaboration and teamwork and developing students' ability to work effectively with others.
- <u>Conflict Resolution</u>: Providing opportunities for students to learn how to resolve conflicts peacefully and constructively.
- <u>Democratic Values</u>: Promoting an understanding of democratic processes and the importance of participation in civic life.

- <u>Appreciating Diversity</u>: Encouraging students to explore and appreciate different cultures, traditions, and perspectives.
- <u>Cultural Exchange</u>: Organising cultural exchange programs and events that allow students to learn from and interact with people from different backgrounds.
- <u>Understanding Cultural Influences</u>: Helping students understand how different cultural influences have shaped their own heritage and the world around them.
