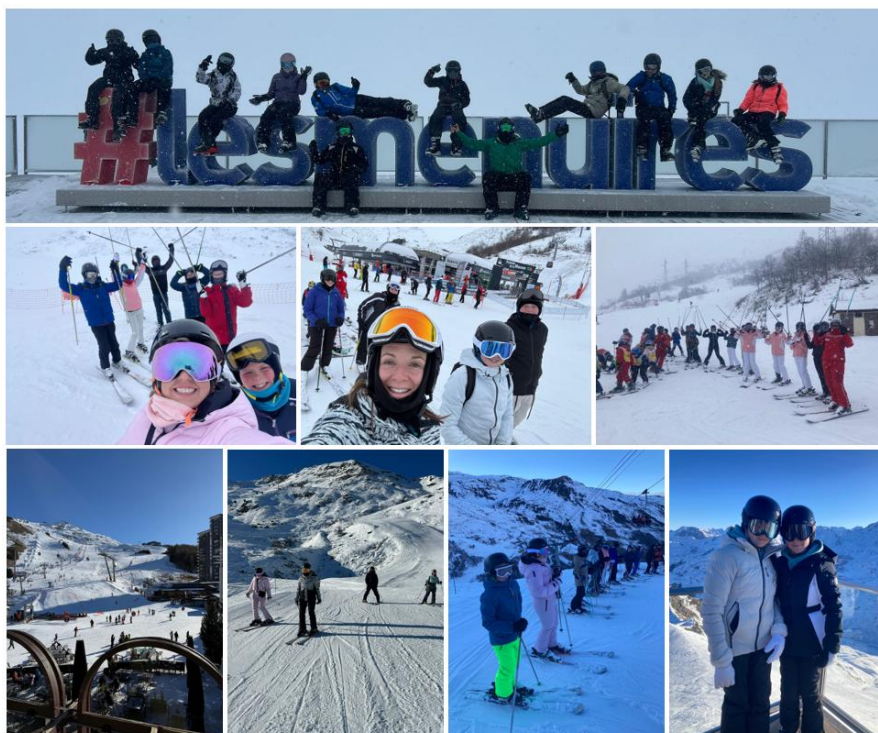

Free Autism Support – Derbyshire

We would like to share details of a free, county-wide support service available across Derbyshire for autistic young people and adults, as well as their families and carers.

The Autism Empowerment, Support and Education Service (AESE) supports individuals aged 16+, including those with a diagnosis of autism, awaiting assessment, or who self-identify as autistic. The service is delivered by autistic professionals and includes online group sessions focusing on communication, emotional wellbeing, self-identity, and reasonable adjustments.

No formal diagnosis is required.

Year 11 Post-16 Transition Day

Sixth Form Taster

As part of the Year 11 Post-16 Transition Day, students who are taking part in the QEGS Sixth Form Taster should arrive at the Boothby Campus at 8.50am on Tuesday 13th January.

Students will be greeted by Sixth Form staff and will attend a brief assembly introducing them to the day's activities. They will also be registered as part of this. Students will then be issued with a mini timetable, outlining where to go for each of their four taster lessons.

Throughout the day, students will have opportunities to ask questions about their Sixth Form application, Sixth Form life and subject choices etc.

Following the taster day, Sixth Form staff will visit a Year 11 assembly in the coming weeks to remind students of the next steps in the application process.

Proposals to change home to school transport policies

Derbyshire School Transport wish to receive views on proposals to change travel policies for eligible school children to 16, Post-16 learners and for students with special educational needs and disabilities. It follows updated legal guidance from the Government providing greater clarity on councils play in helping to transport children to school, giving an opportunity to consider updating current policies to make them more inclusive and promote independence.
