QEGS Ski Tip Jan 2026 - Les Menuires

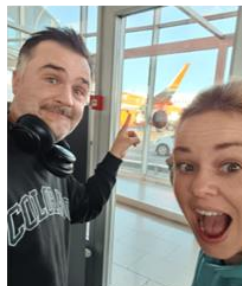


